Clymer, Panama schedule focus group meetings

As part of the centralization feasibility study for the Clymer and Panama central school districts, a series of public focus group meetings will be held in both communities. Focus group meetings are open to the public and are expected to last one hour.

The groups will answer specific questions with facilitation by a consultant group working with the districts. The meetings begin Monday, May 1 and conclude Monday, June 5.

Focus groups include parents, students, senior citizens, faculty, support staff, booster groups, volunteer fire department and other service organizations, agriculture and business leaders and representatives of the Amish community.

Shared Superintendent Bert Lictus is encouraging participation at the meetings.

"Input from our communities is really important," said Lictus. "We hope people will engage in the focus group they most closely relate with. Each session will last approximately an hour. We are trying to get as many people as we can to these focus group meetings. The meetings are an opportunity for residents of Clymer and Panama to participate in the study and share their perspectives."

The consultant team will review current data about school enrollments, expenditure projections, community demographics and more during the meetings. Focus group attendees will then be asked a series of questions. Their answers will be summarized for use with the Feasibility Study Committee and represented in the study.
