Athletic Spectator Policy for the Fall 2020 Season

In accordance with NYSDOH guidance:

- Spectators must maintain **six feet of physical distance** between individuals and/or family/household units at all times
- Spectators must wear **face coverings** when they are in common areas and situations where six feet of distancing is not able to be maintained, so long as they are over the age of two and medically able to tolerate such covering
- Schools must limit spectators to a maximum of **two spectators** per player (not all venues will be able to accommodate the maximum allowable)

Passes: The Chautauqua Cattaraugus Athletic Association (CCAA) will provide spectator passes for all athletes in the league. Each athlete will be given 2 passes. Spectators must have this pass displayed to gain entry to each contest (home or away). Passes **MUST BE** turned back in at the end of the season.

Health Screenings: NYSDOH does not require school districts to do health screenings for spectators. However, some schools have indicated that they intend to do so. Therefore, you may be subject to a health screening at interscholastic athletic contests this school year.

Girls Swimming

Due to the limited seating in the pool, P.C.S. will only be allowing home spectators for our home swim meets. Depending on the venue for an away swim meet, Panama spectators may or may not be granted entry. A list of the away swim meet venue accommodations is below:

Away Swim Meets

10/6 at Frewsburg – No Spectators in Pool/Livestreaming in their Auditorium

10/13 at Jamestown – No Spectators

10/22 at Olean – No Spectators

10/27 at Southwestern – No Spectators

Cross Country

Cross Country venues will be able to accommodate two spectators per athlete. All spectators must display their spectator pass to gain entry to all meets.
